Our home is equipped with multiple stereo surround systems all accessible via Apple AirPlay and Apple AirPlay compatible apps and devices. We keep an iPad in the kitchen wine rack that controls music in the common areas of the home with over a hundred different stations to choose from. You are also welcomed to use your personal device and play your own music. Follow the simple steps below to connect your device.

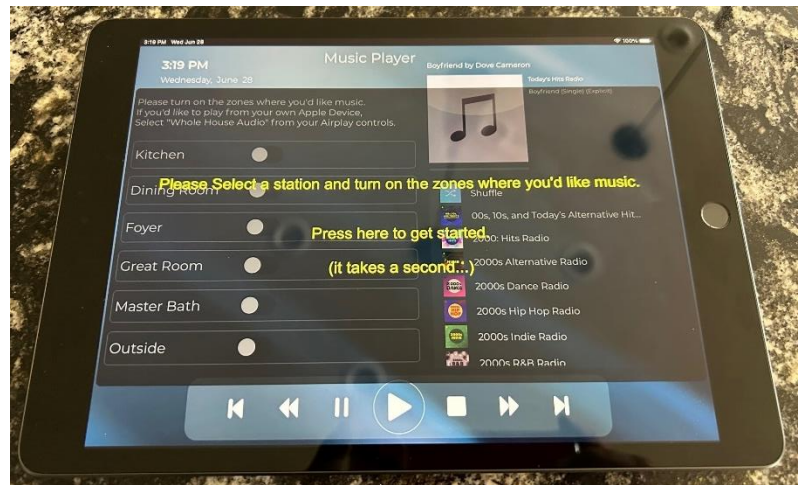
To connect your personal device to one of the AirPlay receivers, simply ensure you are connected to the "Home" WiFi network.

The following zones can be found when you tap the AirPlay button on compatible apps. Simply select one from the AirPlay compatible app to initialize it and begin the music playing.

The 'Whole House Audio' controls the following zones via iPad control or wall touch panels. Only one source can be played on any or all locations simultaneously.

- Kitchen
- Dining Room
- Foyer
- Great Room
- Master Bath
- Outside*



*Outside consists of the speakers by the swing set play area, the speakers across the front of the summer kitchen, under the deck of the master bedroom, and around the pool
